My role is to help occupy the residents the best I can to suit their needs and wants and brighten their day!



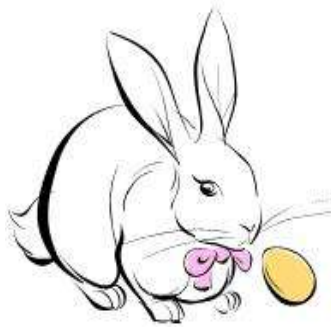
Mother's Day
